JFGBU meeting held in Bank of India, Parliament street New Delhi on 11th March at 10.30 am and all most all the constituent participated in the meeting. Com. D.N.Trivedi presided over the meeting.

At the outset President congratulated all the constituents for making 10th March Dharna all success and historic one under the banner of of JFGBU and he greeted all MPs who had addressed our Dharna on date, particularly for their assurances to support our demand.

Further, President also submitted the outcome of discussion held between Deputy Secretary DFS, Mr AK Dogra, and delegation of JFGBU in his chamber. It was pointed out that there was no change in attitude of DFS by way of quoting the statement of DS, DFS that benefits extended to public sector bank can't be implemented in RRB automatically. During discussion DS also defended the Mitra Committee Manpower planning recommendation,

which is quite unreasonable in present situation prevailing in RRB, that DFS was having no role to amend any Committee report and it has been forwarded to RRBs as usual for adoption. Delegation also raised the issue of non implementation of Compassionate appointment as well as payment of two graduation increment in RRB in line with other Public sector banks. On this count DS categorically reiterated, "unless NABARD, the supervisory authority of RRB, would recommend any issue, DFS would not take those issue independently".

President also pointed out that on the issue of pension DS informed that a Sub-Committee has been constituted under the Chairmanship of NABARD with other five members comprising of GM of SBI, CBI and Chairman of Kerala Gramin Bank, Baroda UP Gramin Bank and Ellaqui Dehati Gramin Bank to submit their report on pension. Further, President also submitted that DFS is defending RRB Act amendment Bill and consequently President opined that in view of above attitude of GOI/DFS there is no way rather to intensify the campaign and struggle under the banner of JFGU.

In view of above two agenda were approved for discussion:


- 1. Protest against RRB Act amendment Bill and Mitra Committee Manpower planning recommendation,**
- 2. Implementation of complete Bipartite settlement including all retiral benefits with retrospective effect.**

After formulation of agenda all most all constituents submitted their views and after a thread bare discussion following final decisions were taken unanimously:

- i) Mass dharna on 27th March at RRB's Head office of the bank,
- ii) Massive Demonstration in Tiffin time/after Office hour on 27th April at every RO,
- iii) **One day token strike on 28th April, 2015.**
- iv) Hereafter NRRBE and NRRBO would be constituent of JFGBU in lieu of AIRRBEA,
- v) Next meeting of JFGBU will be held on next date of listing of Pension case in apex court. to form leading body of JFGBU.

At the end of the meeting President extended thanks to all constituents for unanimous decision and thereafter meeting was concluded.
