## NEWS ROUND UP

Joint Forum of Gramin Bank Unions called for one day Token Strike on 28<sup>th</sup> April, 2015 to demand (i) Parity in Retiral Benefit & (ii) Extension of total salary revision in RRBs and to oppose (iii) RRB Act Amendment Bill and (iv) Imposition of Shri S.K. Mitra Committee Report on HR. the Notice was also sent to the Chief Labour Commissioner (Central). We have received communication from CLC(c) to participate in conciliation proceedings to be held at CLC Office, New Delhi on 20<sup>th</sup> April, 2015 at 3:00 PM. Accordingly it had been decided that JFGBU shall meet in the morning of 20.04.2015 to decide common approach before CLC(c) and shall again meet after the conciliation to decide further course of action. In the meantime all over affiliates should go ahead with the preparations of the strike to make it a grand success.


2. The SLP(c) No. 39288 of 2012, popularly called Pension Case, is likely to be listed on 21<sup>st</sup> April, 2015 as per advance cause list circulated on the Supreme Court Website. The position shall be finally known by 20<sup>th</sup> April, 2015 morning.

3. General Secretary shall be reaching New Delhi on 19<sup>th</sup> April, 2015 to participate in the conciliation Meeting and meeting of JFGBU. He is likely to meet the officials of Govt. of India, Dept. of Financial Services and participate in the proceedings of Supreme Court if the subject SLP comes up for hearing.

4. Com. S.K. Bhattacharjee visited different RRBs of North East during the period from 11<sup>th</sup> to 16<sup>th</sup> April, 2015. Incidentally it can be mentioned here that our Federation had meaningful role in different RRBs in the North East especially in Meghalaya Rural Bank, Assam Gramin Vikash Bank, Arunachal Pradesh Rural Bank and Tripura Gramin Bank. During the period of tour of the General Secretary he visited HO and branches of RRBs, met cross section of officers as well as held Meeting with Management. The visit remained a grand success.
