**CONCILIATION HELD AT CLC(C) OFFICE
NEW DELHI AND ON POSITIVE ASSURANCE OF DFS/NABARD
30TH SEPTEMBER AND 1ST OCTOBER STRIKE DEFERRED**

Conciliation took place in the chamber of Dy., CLC(C), New Delhi on 28th Sept. 2015.

The representatives of DFS, NABARD, RRBs and Sponsor banks participated on behalf of the management. The constituents of UFRRBU also participated on behalf of the Apex Trade Unions of RRBs. At the outset Convenor, UFRRBU, submitted details of 11 points charter of demands which were supplemented by representatives of other constituents. Thereafter, Sri AK Das, Under Secretary, representing DFS, opined that JCC has been directed to hold the meeting on all the issues. The issue of implementation of allowances and other benefits at par has been taken up on priority basis. On 22nd September, sub-committee constituted by JCC has submitted its report to NABARD and as soon as it would come up to DFS for consideration, it would be approved shortly. Further, NABARD representative supplemented him and assured that by Nov-Dec.2015, issues would certainly be settled.

After that, Dy., CLC advise the DFS that due to lack of apex level negotiating Forum for RRBs various disputes are being raised at different level. Therefore, an apex level negotiating forum should be formed as JCC is only consultative forum having no power to decide the issues.

On this count DFS assured that the matter would be taken up on priority basis after receipt of proposals to be provided by Apex Level Trade Unions preferably within a fortnight. Further, DFS representative also opined that matter concerning urgent attention may be discussed at DFS level respectively.

In view of above the proposed strike of 30th Sept. and 1st October has been deferred.

It was decided that even though strike action is deferred for the time being, campaign programme should continue and we should be battle ready to achieve the very important issue of Compassionate Appointment.
